# Changes to Train Times

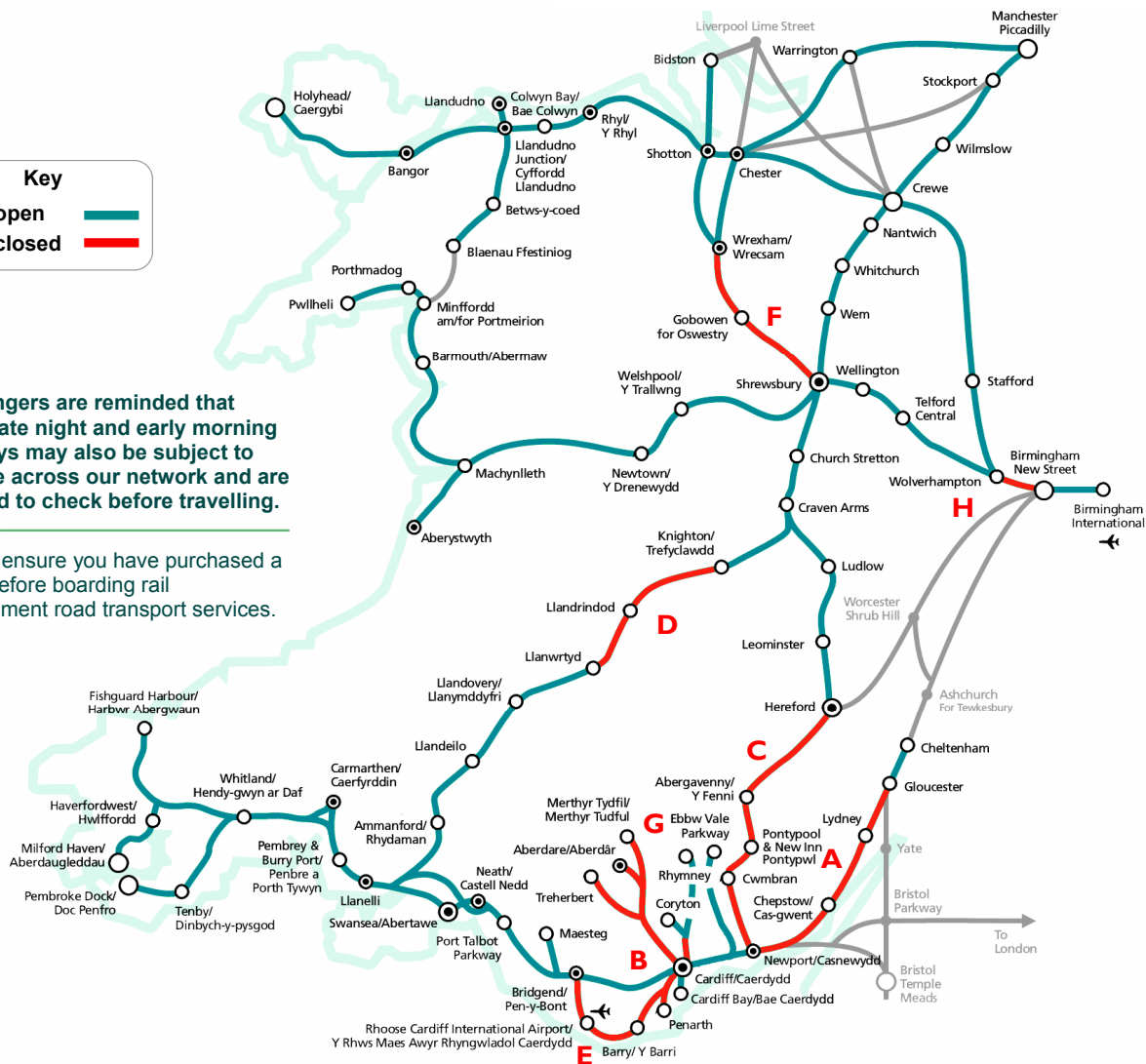

Major engineering work will be taking place during August on the Arriva Trains Wales network at the locations detailed below and this will result in changes to the published timetable. - A Newport to Gloucester**  
Sundays 8<sup>th</sup>, 15<sup>th</sup>, 22<sup>nd</sup>, and 29<sup>th</sup> August until 1430  
Trains between Cardiff Central and Gloucester / Cheltenham Spa will be replaced with road transport between Newport and Gloucester serving all stations via Chepstow and in both directions.
- B Cardiff Central to Heath High Level / Radyr**  
Sunday 8<sup>th</sup> August until 1630 and then from 2130 to close of service  
Train services to/from Aberdare / Merthyr Tydfil / Treherbert will be diverted via the City Line and be unable to call at Cardiff Queen Street, Cathays, and Llandaf. Road transport will operate between Cardiff Central and Radyr, serving Cardiff Queen Street, Cathays, and Llandaf in both directions. Train services to/from the Rhymney Valley will also start from/terminate at Heath High Level with road transport operating to/from Cardiff Central via Cardiff Queen Street in both directions.
- C Newport to Hereford**  
Saturdays 14<sup>th</sup>, 21<sup>st</sup>, and 28<sup>th</sup> August from 2000  
Trains between West Wales / Cardiff Central and Crewe / Manchester Piccadilly / Holyhead will be replaced with road transport between Newport and Hereford serving all stations via Abergavenny and in both directions.
- D Knighton to Llanwrtyd Wells**  
Sunday 22<sup>nd</sup> August  
Trains between Swansea and Shrewsbury via the Heart of Wales Line will be replaced with road transport between Knighton and Llanwrtyd Wells serving all stations via Llandrindod Wells in both directions.

- E Cardiff Central to Barry Island / Bridgend via VoG / Penarth**  
Sunday 22<sup>nd</sup> August until 1230  
Trains will be replaced with road transport between Cardiff Central and Barry Island / Bridgend via VoG / Penarth serving all stations in both directions until 1230.
- F Shrewsbury to Wrexham General**  
Saturday 28<sup>th</sup> and Sunday 29<sup>th</sup> August  
Trains between Birmingham International / Cardiff Central and Holyhead will be replaced with road transport between Shrewsbury and Wrexham General serving Gobowen, Chirk and Ruabon in both directions. Certain services will be diverted between Chester and Shrewsbury via Crewe and customers are advised to check prior to travelling.
- G Radyr to Aberdare, Merthyr Tydfil, & Treherbert**  
Sundays 29<sup>th</sup> August until 1230  
Trains will be replaced with road transport between Radyr and Aberdare / Merthyr Tydfil / Treherbert serving all stations via Pontypridd in both directions until 1230.
- H Birmingham New Street to Wolverhampton**  
Monday 30<sup>th</sup> August  
Trains between Birmingham International and Aberystwyth / Holyhead will be replaced with road transport between Birmingham New Street and Wolverhampton in both directions. Customers travelling between Birmingham New Street and Birmingham International are advised to travel on another train operators services as no Arriva Trains Wales services will operate between these stations.
