Changes to Train Times

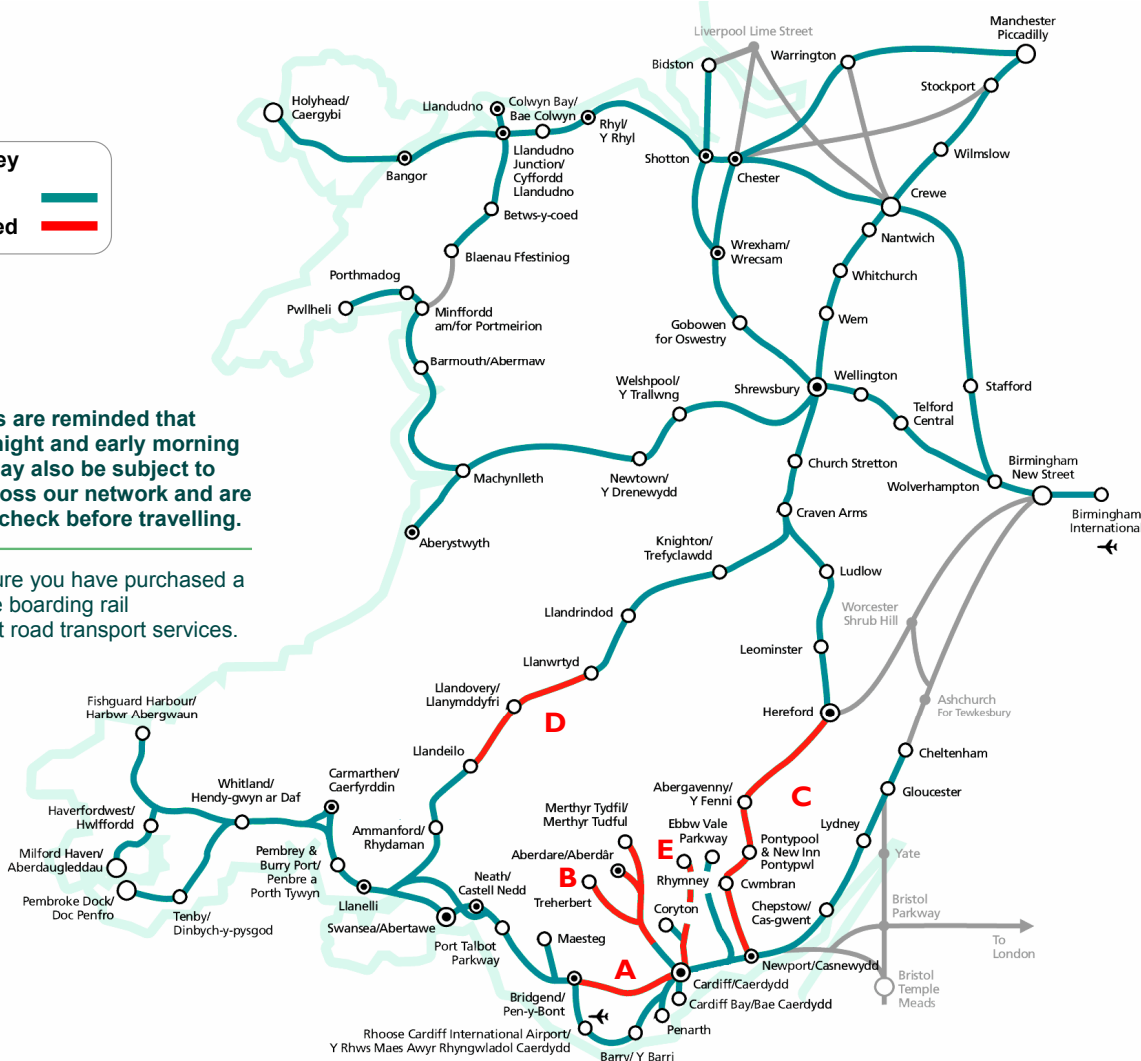

Major engineering work will be taking place during June on the Arriva Trains Wales network at the locations detailed below and this will result in changes to the published timetable. A Cardiff Central to Bridgend

Sundays 6th, 13th, 20th, and 27th June

Trains between Cardiff Central and West Wales will be diverted via the Vale of Glamorgan line. Trains will therefore be unable to serve Pontyclun, Llanharan, and Pencoed and replacement road transport will operate serving these stations in both directions.

B Radyr to Aberdare / Merthyr Tydfil / Treherbert

Sunday 6th June until 1630

Trains will be replaced with road transport between Radyr and Aberdare / Merthyr Tydfil / Treherbert serving all stations via Pontypridd in both directions.

C Newport to Hereford

Saturdays 12th & 19th June (all day) and Saturday 26th June from 2000

Sunday 13th June (all day) and Sundays 20th & 27th June until 1600

Trains between West Wales / Cardiff Central and Crewe / Manchester Piccadilly / Holyhead will be replaced with road transport between Newport and Hereford serving all stations via Abergavenny in both directions.

D Llandeilo to Llanwrtyd Wells

Sunday 20th June

Trains between Swansea and Shrewsbury via the Heart of Wales Line will be replaced with road transport between Llandeilo and Llanwrtyd Wells serving all stations via Llanvory in both directions.

E Cardiff Central to Rhymney

Sunday 20th June until 1215

Trains will be replaced with road transport between Cardiff Central and Rhymney serving all stations via Caerphilly, Ystrad Mynach, and Bargoed in both directions.
