# Changes to Train Times

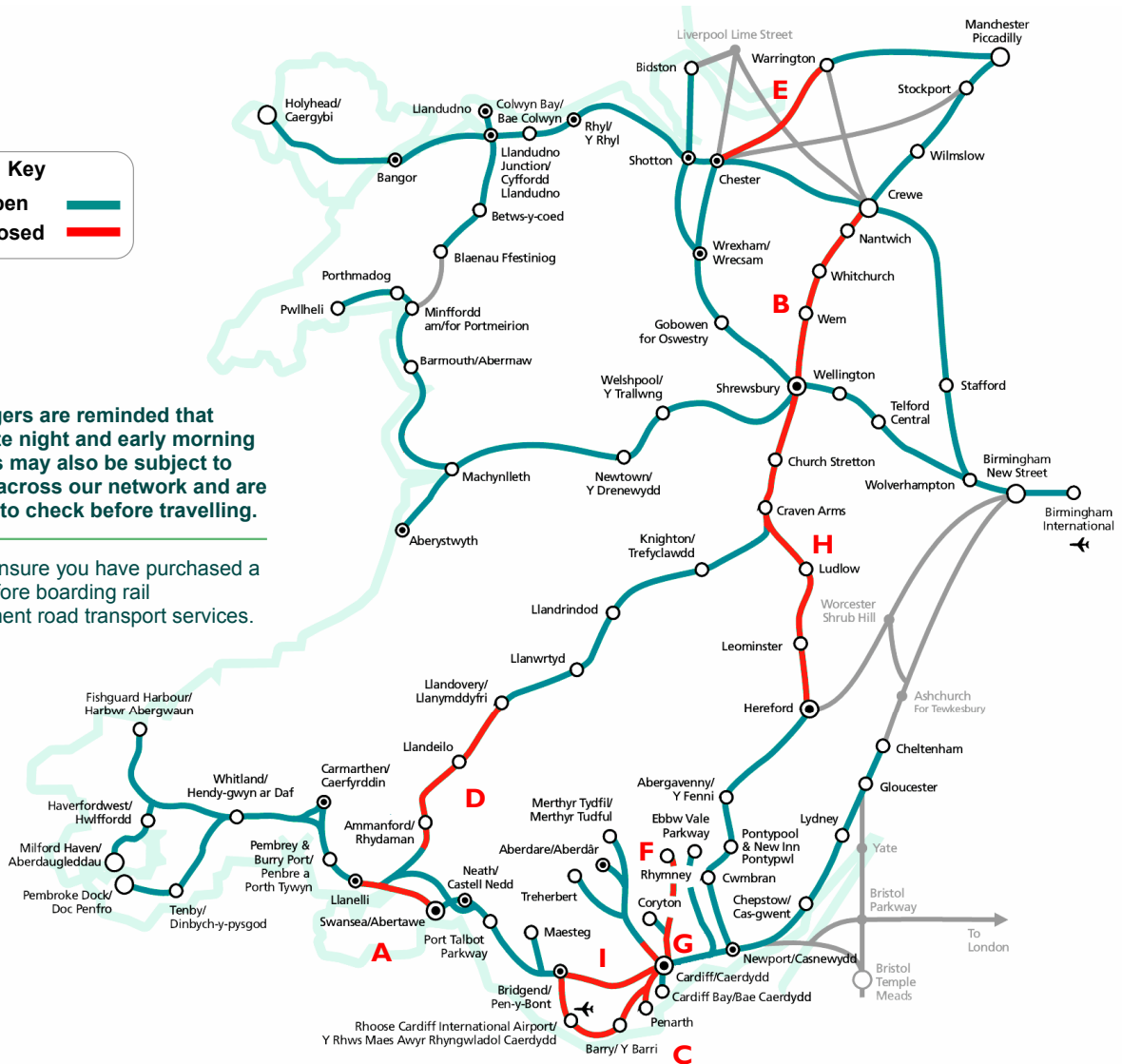

Major engineering work will be taking place during May on the Arriva Trains Wales network at the locations detailed below and this will result in changes to the published timetable. **A** Swansea to Llanelli

**Sunday 2<sup>nd</sup> May**  
Trains between Swansea and Fishguard Harbour / Pembroke Dock / Milford Haven will be replaced with road transport between Swansea and Llanelli serving Gowerton in both directions.

**B** Shrewsbury to Crewe

**Sunday 2<sup>nd</sup> May**  
Trains between West Wales / Cardiff Central and Crewe / Manchester Piccadilly will be diverted (extending journey times) and replaced with road transport between Shrewsbury and Crewe in both directions serving all stations via Wem and Whitchurch (Salop).

**C** Cardiff Central to Barry Island / Bridgend via VoG / Penarth

**Sunday 2<sup>nd</sup> May until 1640**  
Trains will be replaced with road transport between Cardiff Central and Barry Island / Bridgend via VoG / Penarth serving all stations in both directions.

**D** Llandoverly to Pantyffynnon

**Sunday 9<sup>th</sup> May**  
Trains between Swansea and Shrewsbury via the Heart of Wales Line will be replaced with road transport between Llandoverly and Pantyffynnon serving all stations via Llandello in both directions.

**E** Chester to Warrington Bank Quay

**Sundays 9<sup>th</sup> May and 16<sup>th</sup> May until 1235**  
Trains between North Wales / Chester and Manchester Piccadilly will be amended and replaced with road transport between Chester and Warrington Bank Quay in both directions serving all stations via Frodsham. Certain train services will be diverted via Crewe – customers are advised to check their journeys in advance.

**F** Cardiff Central to Rhymney

**Sunday 16<sup>th</sup> May until 1615**  
Trains will be replaced with road transport between Cardiff Central and Rhymney serving all stations via Caerphilly, Ystrad Mynach, and Bargoed in both directions.

**G** Cardiff Central to Heath High Level / Radyr

**Sunday 16<sup>th</sup> May until 1640 and then from 2130 to close of service**  
Train services to/from Aberdare / Merthyr Tydfil / Treherbert will be diverted via an alternative route and replaced with road transport between Cardiff Central and Radyr, serving all stations via Cathays in both directions. Train services to/from the Rhymney Valley will also start/terminate at Heath High Level with road transport operating to/from Cardiff Central via Cardiff Queen Street in both directions.

**H** Hereford to Shrewsbury

**Saturday 22<sup>nd</sup> May from 1930 and all day Sunday 23<sup>rd</sup> May**  
Trains between West Wales / Cardiff Central and Crewe / Manchester Piccadilly will be replaced with road transport between Hereford and Shrewsbury serving all stations via Ludlow in both directions.

**I** Cardiff Central to Bridgend

**Sundays 23<sup>rd</sup> and 30<sup>th</sup> May**  
Trains between Cardiff Central and Swansea / Fishguard Harbour / Pembroke Dock / Milford Haven will be diverted via the Vale of Glamorgan line with replacement road transport operating between Cardiff Central and Bridgend serving Pontyclun, Llanharan, and Pencoed in both directions.
