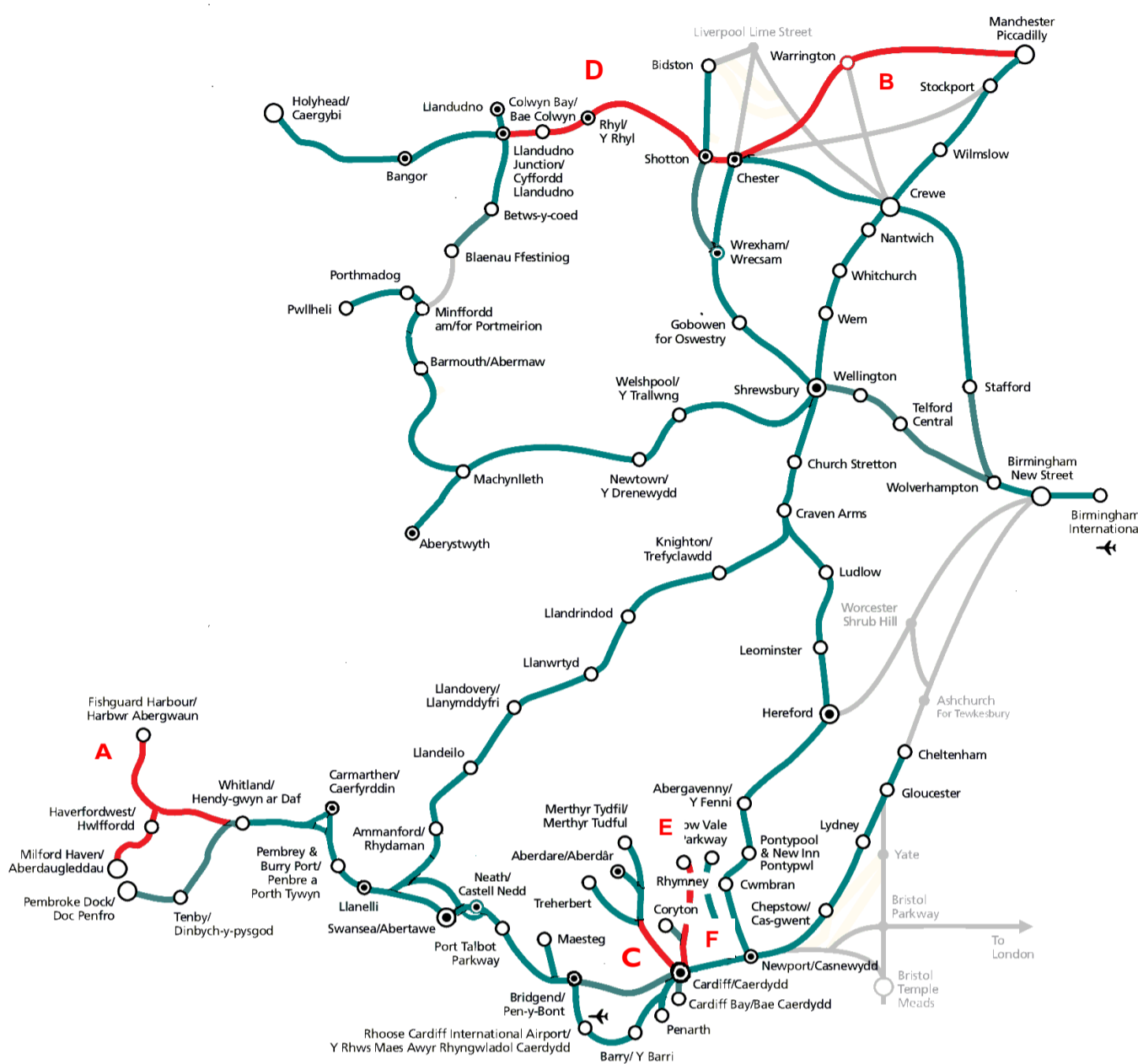

A Whitland to Milford Haven/Fishguard Harbour. Saturday 13 and Sunday 14 January 2018.

A replacement bus service will be in operation between Whitland and Milford Haven/Fishguard Harbour.

Passengers are advised to check their journey plans before travelling.

B Manchester and Chester. Sunday 14 January 2018.

A replacement bus service will be in operation between Manchester Piccadilly and Chester.

Passengers are advised to check their journey plans before travelling.

C Cardiff Central and Pontypridd. Sunday 14 January 2018.

Until 1200, a replacement bus service will be in operation between Cardiff Central and Pontypridd.

D Chester to Llandudno Junction. Sundays 21 and 28 January 2018.

A replacement bus service will be in operation between Chester and Llandudno Jn.

Passengers are advised to check their journey plans before travelling.

E Cardiff Central and Rhymney. Sunday 21 January 2018.

A replacement bus service will be in operation between Cardiff Central and Rhymney (until 1200).

Passengers travelling between Cardiff Queen St and Cardiff Bay should use Cardiff Bus services. Train tickets will be accepted on Cardiff Bay bus services.
