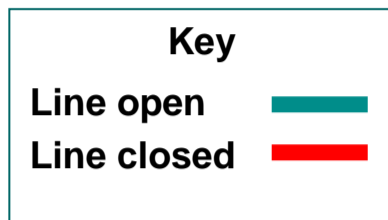
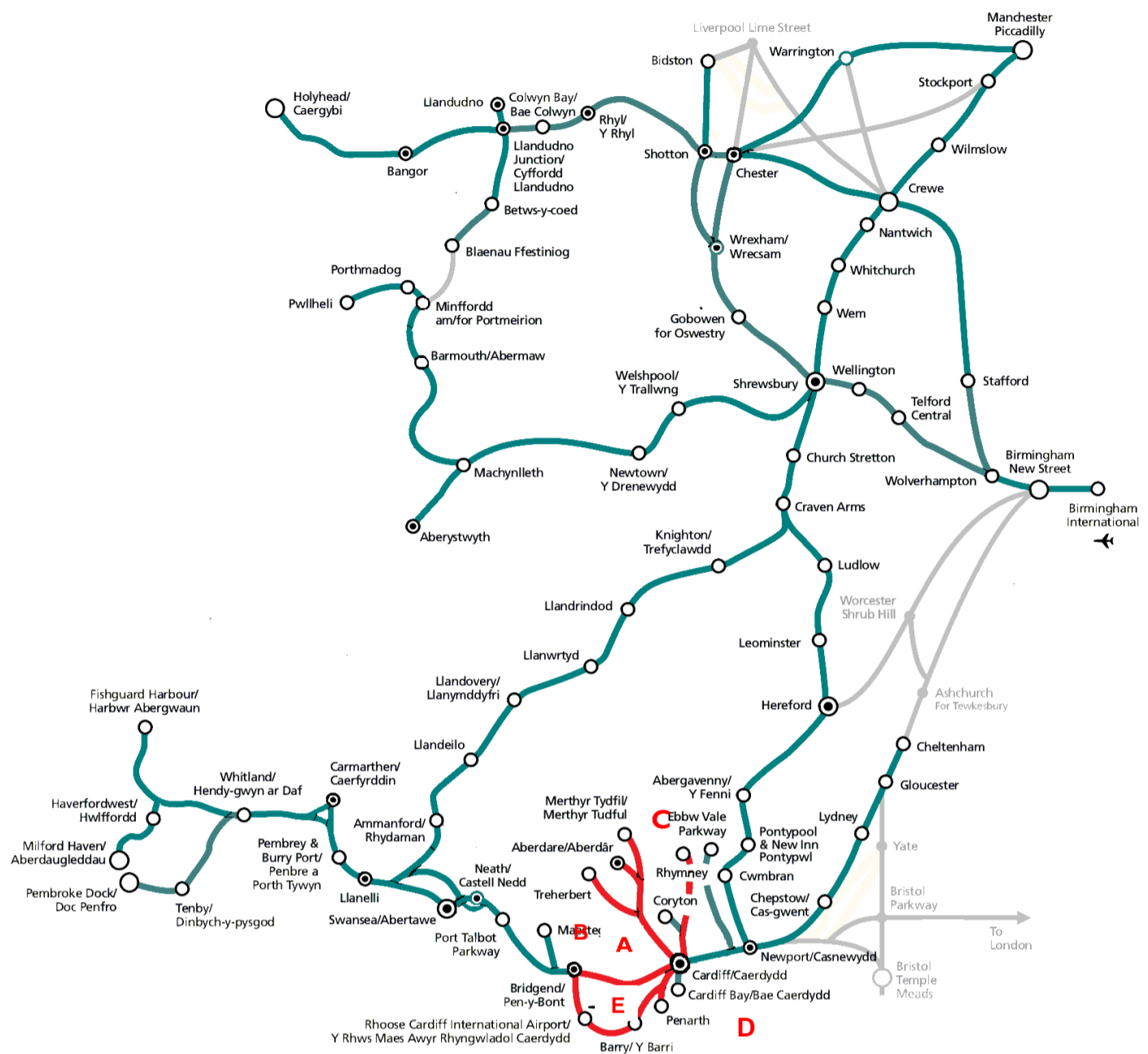


May 2017 Changes to Train Times



Passengers are reminded that some late night and early morning journeys may also be subject to change across our network and are advised to check before travelling.

Major engineering work taking place during May on the Arriva Trains Wales network at the locations detailed below. These are changes to the published timetable. A Cardiff to Pontypridd.

Sunday 7 May.

Until 1230 Sunday, a replacement bus service will be in operation between Cardiff and Pontypridd.

Passengers are advised to check their journey plans before travelling.

B Cardiff to Bridgend.

Saturdays 13 and 20 May, Sunday 21 May.

Mainline services between Cardiff and Bridgend will be diverted via the 'Vale of Glamorgan' route. A replacement bus service will be in operation between Cardiff Central and Bridgend for passengers travelling to Pontyclun, Llanharan, Pencoed and Bridgend.

Passengers are advised to check their journey plans before travelling.

C Cardiff to Rhymney.

Sunday 14 May.

Until 1230 Sunday, a replacement bus service will be in operation between Cardiff and Rhymney.

Passengers are advised to check their journey plans before travelling.

D Cardiff to Radyr.

Sunday 14 May.

Until 1230 Sunday, trains will be diverted via the 'City Line', a replacement bus service will be in operation between Cardiff Central and Radyr for passengers travelling to Cardiff Queen St, Cathays, Llandaff and Radyr. There will be no Cardiff Bay train service, Cardiff Bay train tickets accepted on Cardiff Bus. Passengers are advised to check their journey plans before travelling.

E Cardiff and Barry Island, Penarth and Bridgend on the 'Vale of Glamorgan' line.

Sunday 28 May.

A replacement bus service will be in operation between Cardiff Central and Barry Island, Penarth and Bridgend.

Passengers are advised to check their journey plans before travelling.
