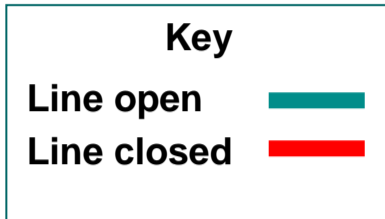
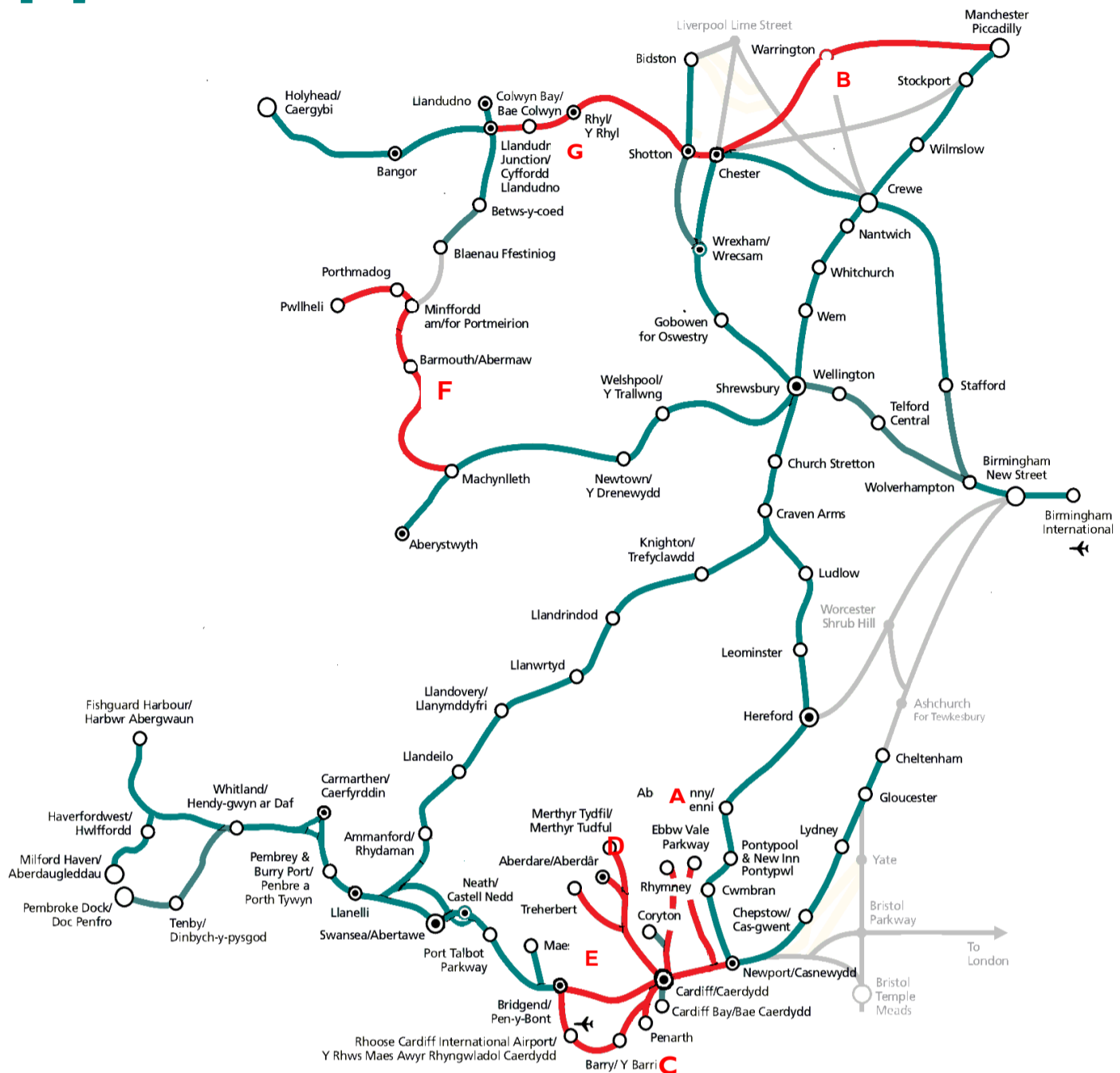


October 2017 i Changes to Train Times



Passengers are reminded that some late night and early morning journeys may also be subject to change across our network and are advised to check before travelling.

Major engineering work taking place during October on the Arriva Trains Wales network at the locations detailed below. These are changes to the published timetable. A Cardiff to Ebbw Vale.

Sunday 1 October.

Until 1330, a replacement bus service will be in operation between Cardiff and Ebbw Vale.

Passengers are advised to check their journey plans before travelling.

B Chester to Manchester Piccadilly.

Saturday 30 September.

Buses replace trains between Warrington Bank Quay and Manchester Piccadilly

Sunday 1 October.

Trains are diverted with buses replacing trains between Chester and Manchester Piccadilly

Passengers are advised to check their journey plans before travelling.

C Cardiff to Barry Island, Penarth and Bridgend via the 'Vale of Glamorgan'.

Sunday 8 October.

Until 1230, buses replace trains between Cardiff and Barry Island, Penarth and Bridgend via the 'Vale of Glamorgan'.

Passengers are advised to check their journey plans before travelling.

D Cardiff and Rhymney.

Sunday 22 and 29 October.

Buses replace trains between Cardiff and Rhymney.

Passengers are advised to check their journey plans before travelling.

E Cardiff and Pontypridd.

Sunday 22 October.

Until 1630, Buses replace trains between Cardiff and Pontypridd.

Passengers are advised to check their journey plans before travelling.

F Machynlleth and Pwllheli.

Saturday 28 and Sunday 29 October.

Buses replace trains between Machynlleth and Pwllheli.

Monday 30 October to Friday 3 November.

Buses replace trains between Barmouth and Pwllheli.

Passengers are advised to check their journey plans before travelling.

G Chester and Llandudno Junction.

Sunday 29 October.

Buses replace trains between Chester and Llandudno Junction.

Passengers are advised to check their journey plans before travelling.

During October, Network Rail will be carrying out structural work between Cardiff and Newport, this is to make the line and bridges along the route ready to support the electrification of the line. This will mean disruption to train services to Manchester, Birmingham, London, Holyhead, Shrewsbury, Gloucester and Ebbw Vale and also services to Maesteg, Swansea and West Wales. Customers are strongly advised to check details of their journey plan before travel.

Sunday 1 October 2017

Sunday: A replacement bus service will be in operation between Cardiff and Newport until 1300.

Monday 2 to Friday 6 October. Train services to Gloucester and Cheltenham Spa, will start and terminate at Newport. Services from Maesteg will start and terminate at Cardiff.

Saturday 7 & Sunday 8 October 2017

Saturday: Train services will be subject to time changes and platform alterations.

Sunday: A replacement bus service will be in operation between Cardiff and Newport until 1300.

Train services to Gloucester, Cheltenham Spa, Manchester Piccadilly and Holyhead will start and terminate at Newport. Services from Maesteg and West Wales will start and terminate at Cardiff until 1300.

Monday 9 to Friday 13 October. Train services to Gloucester and Cheltenham Spa will start and terminate at Newport.

Saturday 14 & Sunday 15 October 2017

Saturday: Manchester Piccadilly services will operate between Newport – Cardiff. Services to Gloucester and Cheltenham Spa, Holyhead will start and terminate at Newport. Maesteg and West Wales will start and terminate at Cardiff.

Sunday: A replacement bus service will be in operation between Cardiff and Newport.

Monday 16 to Friday 20 October. Train services to Gloucester, Cheltenham Spa and Holyhead will start and terminate at Newport. Services from Maesteg and West Wales will start and terminate at Cardiff.

Saturday 21 & Sunday 22 October 2017

Saturday: Most train services will be subject to time changes and platform alterations.

Sunday: A replacement bus service will be in operation between Cardiff and Newport. Services to Gloucester, Cheltenham Spa, Holyhead and Manchester Piccadilly will start and terminate at Newport. Maesteg and West Wales will start and terminate at Cardiff.

Monday 23 to Friday 27 October. Train services to Gloucester, Cheltenham Spa and Holyhead will start and terminate at Newport. Services from Maesteg and West Wales will start and terminate at Cardiff.

Saturday 28 & Sunday 29 October 2017

Saturday and Sunday: Most train services will be subject to time changes and platform alterations, passengers are advised to check their journey before travelling.
